HOW TO DELIVER To preserve the urban decor, users must place waste out no earlier than 8:00 PM the day before collection and no later than 6:00 AM on the same day. For loads over 20 kg, it is necessary to use suitable containers that can be mechanically moved by vehicles. For further information, contact Val Cavallina Servizi S.r.l. at 800.401106.

WHERE TO COLLECT NEW BAGS FOR SEPARATE WASTE COLLECTION Domestic and non-domestic users in Costa Volpino are required to pick up and use only official containers and bags provided by the municipality. If supplies run out, new bags can be collected at the Collection Center in Via Santa Martina using the automated "EcoDispenser" machine. To use it, you need the Regional Services Card of the domestic user. For non-domestic users, the special ecological card can be collected from the municipal tax office.



ORGANIC WASTE

WHERE TO PLACE: available at the municipal offices, holding approximately 20 litres, equipped with a handle and anti-stray lid, with a biodegradable MATER-BI bag inside.

WHAT TO INCLUDE: Cold kitchen scraps, cooked and raw meat scraps, fish, bones, fishbones, skins, spoiled or expired foods, coffee scraps and filters, chamomile tea, fruit and vegetable scraps, peels, pits, bread, pasta, rice, eggshells, cheese, and unused fireplace ash.

PROHIBITED: CUT FLOWERS, GRASS, AND ANIMAL LITTER.



DRY WASTE

WHERE TO PLACE: Transparent Purple Bag-distributed exclusively through the eco-dispenser located at the collection center in Via Santa Martina.

WHAT TO INCLUDE: anything that cannot be separated and sent for recycling. Plastic cutlery, rubber and plastic objects, small toys, rubber sponges and gloves, vacuum cleaner dust and garbage residue, cigarette butts, waxed paper, plastic-coated paper, nylon stockings, gauze, plasters, cotton swabs, gravel or pet litter (in small quantities to prevent the weight from tearing the bag), pencils, pens, tape, toothbrushes, hair, disposable razors, combs, brushes, corks, crown caps, clothes pegs and hangers, diapers and incontinence pads.

PROHIBITED: no other bags and containers



GLASS AND CANS

WHERE TO PLACE: In a rigid container with lid and bottom (max 40-liter capacity), provided by the municipality, equipped with a handle and of sufficient strength to allow easy manual removal by collection service personnel without the contents spilling out and/or breaking the container.

WHAT TO INCLUDE: bottles and jars, cans for drinks/soft drinks and oil, food boxes (tuna, peeled tomatoes, meat, legumes), pet food boxes, caps/closing caps.

PROHIBITED: PLATES, DISHES, PORCELAIN, CERAMICS, AND CRYSTAL (TO BE DISPOSED OF AT THE COLLECTION CENTER AND/OR DRY WASTE). SPRAY CANS, PAINTS, AND GLASS PLATES.



PAPER AND CARDBOARD

WHERE TO PLACE: IN RIGID REUSABLE CONTAINERS (e.g., bins that will be emptied and left on site), OR IN USED CARDBOARD BOXES OR DISPOSABLE PAPER BAGS (Do not place in plastic bags or in bulk).

WHAT TO INCLUDE: newspapers, magazines, notebooks, books, photocopies, sheets of paper in general, cardboard, food boxes in general (pasta, rice), tetrapacks, detergent boxes.

PROHIBITED: laminated covers, parchment, greasy or dirty paper, chemical paper, carbon paper.



PLASTIC

WHERE TO PLACE: IN A TRANSPARENT BAG (PREFERABLY YELLOW) (no bulk packaging, no reusable rigid containers).

WHAT TO INCLUDE Water and soft drink bottles, detergent bottles, soaps, shampoos, plastic containers for fresh food, egg trays, plastic lids, clean plastic plates and glasses.

PROHIBITED: toys, plastic cutlery, durable goods, irrigation hoses, building supplies, bins and baskets, nursery pots, plastic crates, polystyrene.
